Resolution on Increased Funding for Fairfax Police
Approved by the Membership April 28, 2022**

As a Courtesy attached is the updated Public Safety Committee Resolution to the Fairfax County Board to Increase funding for the Fairfax County Police Department to be discussed at the Thursday April 28th Federation Membership Meeting, for approval

Under the advice of the Federation Board, and Federation Budget Committee this resolution was not included in the April 10, 2022, Fairfax County Federation of Citizens Association Letter and Resolution on the Fairfax County FY 2023 Advertised Budget

WHEREAS, FCPD Chief of Police Kevin Davis on February 22, 2022 stated that funding should be increased for the FCPD lower officer pay scale ranks of APPO I, II, III, and PO-I through 2Lt.; and

WHEREAS, FCPD recruiting, retention, and lateral transfer compensation incentives ensure Fairfax County is the police employer of choice in the metropolitan region; and

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED

The FCFCA Public Safety Committee recommends the Board of Supervisors consider all available measures to increase funding for:

- (a) the FCPD lower officer pay scale ranks of APPO I, II, III, and PO-I through 2Lt., and
- (b) recruiting, retention, and lateral transfer compensation incentives to ensure Fairfax County is the police employer of choice in the metropolitan region.
